

Instructions for the Indiana Art Association \$500 Art Scholarship

To be eligible a candidate must:

1. Be a resident of Indiana County;
2. Graduate from high school in Spring 2010;
3. Plan to continue the study of art at a college, university or accredited art school;
4. Submit four pieces of artwork to be judged by an Indiana Art Association juror. Take care that the matting and framing thoughtfully enhances the work.
5. Send the application to the Indiana Art Association, c/o Alice O'Dell, 152 Timbersprings Dr, Indiana, PA 15701 or by email to alicemodell@comcast.net. *The application must be received by Saturday, April 3, 2010.* (no exceptions)
6. The judging will take place on the fourth floor of the Indiana Theatre Building, Room 405, at 637 Philadelphia Street, Indiana, PA on Saturday, April 10, 2010. Enter from the side door on Carpenter alley. Artwork must be dropped off between 10:30 am and 10:45 am and must be picked up at 12:00 noon.
7. The focus is on traditional creative art, rather than commercial or digital images; however, these will be welcomed or considered if they are approached as a fine art form.
