<p>228. STUDENT GOVERNMENT</p>	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Board acknowledges the importance of offering students the opportunity to participate in self government within the schools.</p> <p>The purpose of student government shall be to develop student leadership, provide a learning experience in democratic decision-making, and offer another avenue toward the realization of district goals.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 511</p>	<p>The Board establishes that students shall have the right to organize, conduct meetings, elect officers and representatives, and petition the Board.</p> <p>The Board will recognize the Student Council as the official voice of the student body for students in grades 6-12.</p> <p>The charter, constitution or bylaws of the organization for student government shall be duly adopted by the members of the student body it represents, and approved by the Board.</p>
<p>SC 511</p>	<p>The Board shall appoint a qualified member of the faculty to serve as an advisor for student government activities.</p>
