Unfinished Business:

- Turk and Jim did the walk thru of BES. Everything is okay.

Other unfinished business discussed:

- Derrick from School Claims Service toured the school district with Eric. The findings are as follows:
 - BES – the slide is broken in the playground. Parts have been ordered to fix it.
 - BHS and BMS – Nothing found.
 - SMHS – The bleachers in the Family Section of the existing gym are faded. Will be replaced with the renovation.
 - SMHS - Repairs are needed in the Family Consumer Science Room – Will also be fixed with the renovation.
- School Claims Service was last here in 2006. At that time we had eight findings that needed attention. This time there were only three and after the renovation is complete, everything will be clean. SCS will return again in three years.
- We also discussed other projects scheduled for the coming year. The BHS Library will be re-carpeted and another phase of the Blairsville Campus parking lot will be done.

- BES Aide – A computer fell on her foot when she caught her cart on it. Medical.
